About the NSW Fencing Centre

AFC4 will be held at the new NSW Fencing Centre - Building 2, Sydney Corporate Park, 190 Bourke Road, Alexandria NSW 2015.

Getting there

The Centre is located halfway between Sydney Airport and the CBD, about a \$30 taxi ride either way. If you are taking Uber from the domestic terminal, follow the signs to the priority pick up area on the Virgin/Jetstar side of the parking building and book your ride from there.

The nearest train station is Mascot on the Airport Line - an 8-minute walk north along Bourke Road to the Centre. Mascot is one stop from the domestic terminal and two stops from Central. If travelling by train you'll need an Opal card which you can get at railway stations and newsagents.



When entering Sydney Corporate Park from Bourke Road, walk 100 metres to the roundabout and the Fencing Centre is on your right. Look for the sign.

You can also drive or walk through from O'Riordan Street.



Parking is available at \$7 per day at Sydney Corporate Park and at 55 Doody Street in the same block.

Fencing Centre

The NSW Fencing Centre is in the first floor of Building 2.

The Centre is accessible via stairs and a lift.

Weapons check and bag storage will be on the ground floor of Building 2. This is common property so please be considerate of our neighbours and keep your bags tidy within the designated area.

Pistes 1 - 9 are in the Centre. Ancillary pistes 10 - 11 are in the Dance Centre next door. Follow the signs.

The Centre has a cafe selling food, coffee and cold drinks all day.

The Centre is equipped with toilets, showers and temporary change rooms.
